**Abstract**

The PRISMA project aims to enhance human well-being and promote an inclusive society by analyzing migrants' access to social and healthcare services in Small and Medium Towns (SMTs) across Italy. Focusing on six case studies in three regions, the project explores how local factors—such as demographics, institutional structures, and geographic settings—shape integration processes. Using an intersectional and participatory approach, PRISMA views access and accessibility to services as key indicators of socio-structural integration, including various migrant categories such as refugees and asylum seekers. The project emphasizes not only service use but also migrants' involvement in local planning. Ultimately, PRISMA will deliver evidence-based policy tools and guidelines, compiled in a White Paper, to support local governments in improving service delivery and addressing inequalities in SMTs.
